## Head 'em out

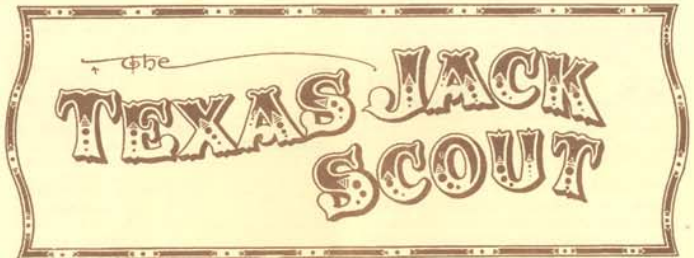

**Following the Applegate Trail Today**

The Applegate Trail Wagon Train 1993 reenactment heads down Fandango Pass in northwest California near the Oregon border.

In 1843 Jesse Applegate and his brother Lindsay saw their two 10-year-old sons drown while crossing the Columbia River. "It was a painful scene beyond description," Lindsay wrote. In their grief, these fathers swore they would find a drier, safer migration route for the covered wagons coming from the East, hence the creation of the Applegate Trail.
